## SOCIAL MEDIA WARNING

The GCA has introduced a new social media clause to its constitution regarding harassment through the use of electronic messages and social media. Please make yourself familiar with the clause, which is listed below.

1. The existing passage In Clause 8 "*Harassment*" now becomes Clause 8 (a).

2. The following Clause 8 (b) has been added:
